A mile-long drive through the Pumpkintown Forest with 17 scenes and over 30 Pumpkinheads. Scavenger hunt and counting game.

The Village

Good to know:

- Tickets for the Village and The Ride are sold separately.
- You can leave the Village and come back the same day. Be sure to get your hand stamped.
- Grab a *Village Scavenger Hunt* game sheet at check-in.
- The Donut Shack in the Village is cash only. There is an ATM just outside the Harvest Store.
- Restrooms are located in the Harvest Store and the main store. Port-o-lets are located outside the main store.

A few rules:

To make sure everyone's visit to Pumpkintown is a happy and safe one:

- Children must be supervised at all times
- No running in the Village
- Don't touch the Pumpkin people (they're very skiddish!)



The Ride

Half the fun is across the street in the Pumpkintown Forest. You'll find 17 more scenes and over 30 more Pumpkinheads!

Good to know:

- Drive across the street and follow the signs to check in.
- You can purchase snack packages for your drive. Packages are cash only. There is an ATM just outside the Harvest Store.
- Ask for a *Trail Games* sheet and see if you can find all the scavenger hunt items we've placed in the Forest.
- You can do a second loop for an additional \$10 per car.

A few rules:

- Remain in your car at all times
- Keep moving and obey the posted speed limit.
