The Village

Good to know:

- Tickets for The Village and The Hayride are sold separately, cash or credit.
- You can leave The Village and come back the same day. Be sure to get your hand stamped.
- Grab a *Village Scavenger Hunt* game sheet at check-in.
- The Chicken Shack in the Village is cash only. There is an ATM just outside the Harvest Store.
- Restrooms are located in the Harvest Store and the main store. Port-o-lets are located outside the main store.

A few rules:

To make sure everyone's visit to Pumpkintown is a happy and safe one:

- Children must be supervised at all times
- No running in the Village
- Don't touch the Pumpkin people (they're very skiddish!)
- Dogs are not allowed in the Village, Harvest Store or on the Hayride

The Hayride

Half the fun is across the street in the Pumpkintown Forest. You'll find 17 more scenes and over 30 more Pumpkinheads!

Good to know:

- *Weekdays:* Drive across the street and follow the signs to check in.
- *Weekends:* A crossing guard will help you cross the street.
- The Donut Shack and the Coffee Shack are cash only. There is an ATM outside the Donut Shack.
- Ask for a *Trail Games* sheet and see if you can find all the scavenger hunt items we've placed in the Forest.

The Christmas Ride

The Pumpkintown Forest is transformed into a holiday winter wonderland reminiscent of bygone days. Open the Friday after Thanksgiving through December 31st.

The Harvest Store

- Fresh local produce replenished daily
- Local artisan wares
- Fall decor
- Fresh apple cider donuts baked daily at our own Donut Shack

- Open year-round
- Perennials, annuals, shrubs
- Colorful Fall mums
- Christmas trees and holiday shop

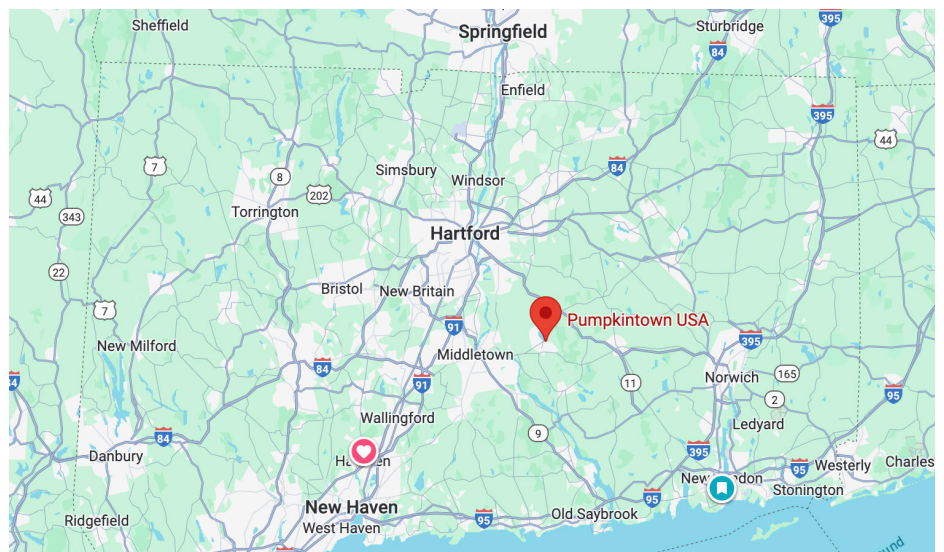
